#### Before the dance:

- Notify the Super Square Head, Stephanie Stevens, (408-871-9525) of any needed changes to assigned dates.
- The designated Square Heads should arrive by **6:15** PM.and stay until clean up is finished around 9:45 PM. A Katydids member with a key will open the doors and will secure the hall at end of evening.
- Check the restrooms for supplies & tidiness.
- Because of COVID we will not be providing drinks or snacks
- Sweep the floor as necessary & set up 3 tables: the sign-in, flyer and caller tables.
- Set up at least 25 chairs. Bring out more chairs as needed during the evening.
- Place hand sanitizer and flyers on table
- Set up the easel & board to receive the birthday/ anniversary dates provided by the Treasurer.

### **During Club dance:**

- Welcome everyone as they enter.
- Collect a **\$6.00** donation from each guest and have them sign in. "Regular" guests check the prepared guest sheet, new guests sign the guest book.
- In the green box, there is an envelope with \$70 petty cash for making change.
- Check the member sign-in list to see if we have any members on LOA. If they attend, they pay a \$6.00 donation.
- Offer 50/50 raffle tickets: 5 tickets for \$1.00.
- In the green box, there are envelopes for keeping track of money collected during the evening.
- Divide the raffle proceeds with 50% to the Club, 50% to the winner. (Note: odd dollar goes to the winner!)
- After announcements and raffle, feel free to dance EXCEPT for the last tip (unless you are needed to fill a square) when you will need to be putting things away and cleaning up

### After the dance:

- If Treasurer is not present, pass monies collected to any Executive Board Member.
- Pack up the sign-in table items
- Wipe counter and tables where needed.
- Empty garbage can. The dumpster is located in the side parking lot.
- Sweep up crumbs from the floor.
- Return chairs to the storage room
- Notify Stephanie and Naomi if we need more Club event flyers or *Chirpers* printed for the following week
- Notify the Quartermasters, Bea (408-224-8164) or Liv (408-997-2305) of any replacement supplies needed for the next week.
