Before the dance:

 Notify the Super Square Head, Stephanie Stevens, (408-871-9525) of any needed changes to assigned dates.

• YOU DO NOT NEED TO BRING ICE!

- On scheduled night, the designated Square Heads should arrive by 6:15 PM. and stay until clean up is finished around 9:45 PM. A Katydids member with a key will open the doors and will secure the hall at end of evening.
- Check the restrooms for supplies & tidiness.
- Make ice water using provided cubes in freezer and make coffee.
- Sweep the floor as necessary & set up the sign-in table.
- Bring out additional chairs from storage room as needed.
- Set up drinks and supplies on counter.
- Place snacks, napkins and flyers on tables at back of the hall

During Club dance:

- Welcome everyone as they enter.
- Collect a \$5.00 donation from each guest and have them sign in. "Regular" guests sign the prepared sheet, new guests sign the guest book.
- In the green box, there is an envelope with petty cash for making change.
- Offer raffle tickets: 5 tickets for \$1.00.
- In the green box, there are envelopes for keeping track of money collected during the evening.
- Divide the raffle proceeds with 50% to the Club, 50% to the winner. (Note: odd dollar goes to the winner!)
- Check that water & cups do not run out during the night.
- After announcements and raffle, feel free to dance except for the last tip (unless you are needed to fill a square) when you will need to be putting things away and cleaning up

After the dance:

- If Treasurer is not present, pass monies collected to any Executive Board Member.
- Pack up the sign-in items, leftover snacks and flyers.
- Empty coffee pot and dry the cooler and pack up other supplies and return them to the shelf in storage room.
- Wipe counter and tables where needed.
- Empty garbage can if more than half full. The dumpster is located in the side parking lot.
- Sweep up crumbs from the floor as needed.
- Return extra chairs to the storage room
- Notify the Quartermaster, Lloyd (408-482-9320) of any replacement supplies needed for the next week.



We will be looking for volunteers to help us with the many jobs that need to be done at the dance. Pat will be coming around looking for help.



From the Kitchen of Janna Standridge --

CHOCOLAATAE MOUSSE PIE WITH GRAHAM CRACKER CRUST

Graham Cracker Crust, 9" deep dish, preheat oven to 375°

1 ½ cups **GRAHAM CRACKER**, medium fine crumbs

½ cup SUGAR

6 tablespoon BUTTER, melted

Mix all together. Press into 9" deep dish round. Bake in 375 oven for 9 minutes. Cool.

For a crowd:

2 cups **GRAHAM CRACKER**, medium fine crumbs

34 cup SUGAR

8 tablespoon **BUTTER**, melted

Mix all together. Press into 9x13 baking pan. Bake in 375° oven for 9 minutes. Cool.

Pie Filling

12 oz **SEMI-SWEET CHOCOLATE CHIPS** (Nestle's is just fine)

1 WHOLE EGG, room temp

2 EGG YOLKS, room temp

2-4 tablespoon RUM*,**

(DON'T use spiced or flavored rums)

(DON'T overdo the liquor or your pie will be bitter and/or runny)

2 EGG WHITES, room temp

2 cups WHIPPING CREAM, chilled, divided

2 teaspoon **PURE VANILLA EXTRACT**, divided

2 tablespoon **POWDERED SUGAR**, divided

1 sq UNSWEETENED CHOCOLATE

Melt **CHIPS** over a double boiler (make sure NO water gets into the chocolate). Remove from heat. One at a time beat in WHOLE EGG, then EGG YOLKS. Stir in RUM. Use an electric mixer to beat EGG WHITES until stiff, set aside. (eggs, bowl & beaters should be room temp). Clean beaters. Put a separate mixing bowl & beaters in freezer for 10 min. Using chilled bowl & beaters, whip 1 cup WHIPPING CREAM, 1 tablespoon POWDERED SUGAR, 1 teaspoon VANILLA, until stiff. Gently fold EGG WHITES and WHIPPED CREAM into CHOCOLATE mixture. Pour into pie shell. Chill at least 30 min. Before serving, put mixing bowl & beaters in freezer for 10 min. Whip last 1 cup WHIPPING CREAM, 1 teaspoon VANILLA & 1 tablespoon POWDERED SUGAR until stiff. Spread whipped cream on top of pie, creating peaks. Use a vegetable peeler, shave UNSWEETENED CHOCOLATE on top of WHIPPED CREAM.

Enjoy!																												
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This pie can be made a day or two ahead. The crust & filling take about 1 hour, not counting chilling time.

- * 50ml bottles are just perfect for this recipe. I usually get these at <u>Beverages & More</u> or a liquor store.
- ** You can also use other liquors in place of Rum:

Grand Marnier: for an orangechocolate flavor

Frangelico: for a hazelnutchocolate flavor

Chambord: for a raspberry-chocolate flavor

See the gorilla and lioness (in white) facing each other.




• The 2nd and 3rd "T's" are two people sharing (or fighting over) a tortilla and a bowl of salsa.



From the Kitchen of Pat Angotti --

PUMPKIN PIE CRUNCH

Preheat oven to 350°F Lightly grease a 9 x 13" baking dish

Ingredients

- 1 (29 ox.) can pumpkin puree
- 3 eggs, lightly beaten
- 1 (12 Oz.) can evaporated milk
- 1 1/4 c. sugar
- 2 -3 tsp ground pumpkin pie spice
- 1 (18.25 oz) pkg yellow cake mix
- 1 c. graham cracker crumbs
- 1/2 c. toffee bits
- 1 c. butter, melted

Layers

- Dump pumpkin puree, eggs, evaporated milk, sugar and pumpkin pie spice into prepared baking dish. Stir ingredients together until well blended, scrape down sides and spread evenly.
- 2. Sprinkle dry cake mix evenly over pumpkin mixture
- 3. Sprinkle with graham cracker crumbs. Scatter toffee bits over the top
- 4. Drizzle melted butter oiver all.

Bake

50 to 55 minutes or until cake is lightly browned and tests done with a toothpick. Cool before serving. Refrigerate overnight, if desired.
