Before the dance:

• Notify the Super Square Head, Stephanie Stevens, (408-871-9525) of any needed changes to assigned dates.

YOU DO NOT NEED TO BRING ICE!

 On scheduled night, the designated Square Heads should arrive by 6:15 PM. and stay until clean up is finished around 9:45 PM. A Katydids member with a key will open the doors and will secure the hall at end of evening.

• Check the restrooms for supplies & tidiness.

 Make ice water using provided cubes in freezer and make coffee.

• Sweep the floor as necessary & set up the sign-in table.

• Bring out additional **chairs** from storage room as needed.

• Set up drinks and supplies on counter.

 Place snacks, napkins and flyers on tables at back of the hall

During Club dance:

• Welcome everyone as they enter.

• Collect a \$5.00 donation from each guest and have them sign in. "Regular" guests sign the prepared sheet, new guests sign the guest book.

• In the green box, there is an envelope with petty cash for making change.

• Offer raffle tickets: 5 tickets for \$1.00.

 In the green box, there are envelopes for keeping track of money collected during the evening.

• Divide the raffle proceeds with 50% to the Club, 50% to the winner. (Note: odd dollar goes to the winner!)

• Check that water & cups do not run out during the night.

• After announcements and raffle, feel free to dance except for the last tip (unless you are needed to fill a square) when you will need to be putting things away and cleaning up

After the dance:

 If Treasurer is not present, pass monies collected to any Executive Board Member.

• Pack up the sign-in items, leftover snacks and flyers.

• Empty coffee pot and dry the cooler and pack up other supplies and return them to the shelf in storage room.

• Wipe counter and tables where needed.

• Empty garbage can if more than half full. The dumpster is located in the side parking lot.

• Sweep up crumbs from the floor as needed.

• Return extra chairs to the storage room

 Notify the Quartermasters, Maxine or Lloyd (408-241-7567) of any replacement supplies needed for the next week.



Something new to save the Santa Clara Area Square Dance Community...

Starting the first 3 weeks of January 2018 **Jim, Roger & Bob** will begin CALLERLAB S.S.D. (Sustainable Square Dancing) 12 Week - 50 Call - Lessons. The first three weeks are Introductory Lessons. Students will graduate after about 12 weeks of non-introductory lessons and when/if there are graduates they will be given an opportunity to dance S.S.D. at one or more local clubs as well as S.S.D. Hoedowns. They will also be given the opportunity to progress to more advanced dancing (Plus, Advanced...) at their discretion and capability/interest. Hopefully they will remain at S.S.D. / Mainstream for at least 2 years before moving on.

The intent is to have classes start about every 12 - 15 weeks. So potential students will NOT have to wait a year for the next class start.

PLEASE Support Your Local S.S.D. class. As a Class Recruiter, Angel, and Non-Plus Hoedown Attendee when the hoedowns occur. Angel, visiting Caller, dancing dancer, Please PAY at the door. FREE dancing insures YOU will soon NOT have a corner.

NOTE: SCVSDA has conducted nearly 50 GDP Hoedowns. There has never been a GDP Class (though Jim tried). So there are NO new dancers fitting SCVSDA goal/reasoning for having GDP exist. http://scvsda.org/gdp/faq.html#g.goal



From the Kitchen of – – – Roger Johnson

STUFFED MUSHROOMS

45 minutes prep time

20 minutes cook time

1 pkg Jimmy Dean Premium Pork Regular Sausage

2 lbs large mushrooms, stems removed & reserved 1 clove garlic, minced

4 oz cream cheese, cubed, softened

3/4 c. dry Italian bread crumbs, divided

1/2 c (2 oz) grated Parmesan cheese, divided

1/4 c. fresh parsley

1 T. olive oil

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°F Finely chop enough mushroom stems to measure 1 cup; discard any remaining stems. Place mushroom caps, rounded sides down, in lightly greased shallow baking pans.
- 2. Cook sausage, chopped stems and garlic in large skillet over MEDIUM_HIGH heat 8-10 minutes or until sausage is thoroughly cooked, stirring frequently; drain. Return to skillet. Add cream cheese, 1/2 c. breadcrumbs, 1/4 c. Parmesan cheese and parsley; mix well. Spoon into mushroom caps.
- 3. Combine remaining breadcrumbs, remaining Parmesan cheese and oil; sprinkle over mushrooms.
- 4. Bake 20 minutes or until mushrooms are tender and stuffing is lightly browned.
