#### **BEFORE THE DANCE:**

- Notify the Super Square Head, Stephanie Stevens, (408-499-9182) of any needed changes to assigned dates.
- The designated Square Heads should arrive by 6:15pm. A
  Board member with key access will open the gates and will
  secure the hall at the end of the evening.
- Check the restrooms for supplies and tidiness.
- Set up two rectangular tables, one for sign-in and one for snacks and water. Use a table covering.
- Another table goes in front of the piano. Use the orange strap to keep it in place
- Flyers go onto the freezer
- Fill the pitcher with water. Ice machine is in the kitchen.
- Place hand sanitizer on the sign-in table, snack table, passthrough to the kitchen and on each round table.
- If there are birthdays or anniversaries, set up the board.

#### **DURING CLUB DANCE:**

- Welcome everyone as they enter
- Collect an \$8.00 donation from each dancing guest and have them sign in. Non-dancing guests don't pay but do sign in.
   Those members who are of Leave of Absence pay \$8.00.
- Offer 50/50 raffle tickets. 5 tickets for \$1.00. Divide the raffle proceeds with 50% to the Club and 50% to the winner. (Note: odd dollar goes to the winner!)
- Note that there is another donation box. Collected money to be split 50% to Club and 50% to Jim.
- In the green box, there are square head envelopes for keeping track of money collected during the evening.
- After announcements and raffle, feel free to dance EXCEPT for the last tip (unless you are needed to fill a square) when you will need to be putting things away and cleaning up.
- If Treasurer is not present, pass monies collected to any Executive Board Member.

#### **AFTER THE DANCE:**

- Pack up the sign-in and snack table items into the bins.
   Remember the flyers.
- Reset the hall to the way we found it.
- Notify Stephanie and Naomi if we need more Club event flyers or *Chirpers* printed for the following week







## Interesting information on Square Dancing at the County Fair

In mid-February, Marcella, who is with the Santa Clara County Fairgrounds Heritage Foundation (FHF) inquired of our caller, Jim, about the history of square-dancing at the county fair.

Marcella said: "One of the aspects of the heritage foundation is collecting and documenting the history of the fairgrounds. I have been working with FHF since 2019 on this project of locating and preserving the history of all activities and events that have happened during the years at the fairgrounds. culminates in the displays at the heritage exhibit each year during the county fair. A piece of history that I have no documents, photos or memorabilia of is the many years that the square dance clubs have used the fairgrounds, dancing during the fair or square dance festivals and events held during the year. I have fond memories of my youth watching the square dancers and many visitors tell us their stories of watching the square dancing. It is a piece of history that I would like to include for the heritage exhibit for 2023.d I'm hoping to collect enough photos and information that I can dedicate a display to square dance history at the fairgrounds..."

#### Jim responded with:

"I believe a dancer named Mac McClure as an officer in the **SCVSDA** (Santa Clara Square Dancers Assoc) was instrumental in getting Square Dancing at the Fair. Mac was a San Jose School Administrator & hadCONNECTIONS. My Father In-Law Andy VanDerostyne was a construction supervisor & was also active inSCVSDA. Andy basically implemented Mac & SCVSDA plans & built "The Slab" + Stage, using Dancers & Callers that had construction experience & resources. I believe the YELLOW text "SCVSDA 1982" & the plaque on the stage indicate completion date. I also believe "The Slab" & Stage were 100% financed by the SCVSDA. SCVSDA &SCVCA (Santa Clara Valley Callers Assoc) also expected to receive long term FREE admission to the Fair forDancers in Colorful Attire as entertainment dancing at the fair. The Fair only supplied the physical location."

From the Kitchen of: Stephanie Stevens

#### Texas Caviar (dip)

This was a recipe from Joan Ryan a former Katydids member.

- 1-15 oz can Blackeyed peas, drained & rinsed
- 1-4oz can chopped black olives
- ½ medium green bell pepper, finely chopped
- 4 green onions (white plus 2" of green), chopped
- 2 garlic cloves, minced
- ¼ c. minced pickled jalapeño peppers
- 1 t. ground cumin
- 2 T. chopped fresh cilantro
- 1 T. cider vinegar
- ¼ t. salt
- 2 T. olive oil

Combine all ingredients and mix well.
