Before the dance:

 Notify the Super Square Head, Stephanie Stevens, (408-871-9525) of any needed changes to assigned

- The designated Square Heads should arrive by 6:15 PM and stay until clean up is finished around 9:45 PM. A Katydids member with a key will open the gates and will secure the hall at end of evening.
- Check the restrooms for supplies & tidiness.
- Because of COVID we will not be providing drinks. Single serving commercially made & wrapped snacks are welcomed.
- In the hall, set up 1 table for signing in. Flyers can go onto the top of the freezer.
- One unopened table needs to go in front of the piano
- Place hand sanitizer on sign-in table at at front of hall
- Set up the easel & board to receive the birthday/ anniversary dates provided by the Treasurer.

During Club dance:

- Welcome everyone as they enter.
- Collect a \$6.00 donation from each guest and have them sign in. "Regular" guests check the prepared guest sheet, new guests sign the guest book.

 • In the green box, there is an envelope with \$70 petty
- cash for making change.
- Check the member sign-in list to see if we have any members on LOA. Those on LOA pay our Guest Donation of \$6.00.
- Offer 50/50 raffle tickets: 5 tickets for \$1.00.
- In the green box, there are envelopes for keeping track of money collected during the evening.
- Divide the raffle proceeds with 50% to the Club, 50% to the winner. (Note: odd dollar goes to the winner!)
- After announcements and raffle, feel free to dance EXCEPT for the last tip (unless you are needed to fill a square) when you will need to be putting things away and cleaning up
- If Treasurer is not present, pass monies collected to any Executive Board Member.

- Return facility chairs, tables


And this, just in we **MIGHT** be dancing on Friday, 31 December after all. Keep the evening open and be looking for more details to come.
